Numbers 14:24; 32:12; Deuteronomy 1:36; Joshua 14:8-9; Psalm 86:11 NIV

- 1) He plead & pushed the people to proceed with God’s plan Numbers 13:27-28,30-32; 14:5-10a
- 2) He had the proper perspective as he perceived his place
- 3) He was a man of great purpose & passion: He pursued what God has promised
- 4) He was persistent
- 5) He passed it along to the next generation

Lessons we learn and can apply this week

1. The Lord’s call for everyone is to follow Him wholeheartedly this week – with everything that we are!
