

JOSHUA: STRONG & COURAGEOUS

"God's Not Done With You Yet" Joshua 14:6-13 November 7, 2021

Caleb was a man who wholeheartedly followed the Lord Numbers 14:24; 32:12; Deuteronomy 1:36; Joshua 14:8-9; Psalm 86:11 NIV

- 1) He plead & pushed the people to proceed with God's plan Numbers 13:27-28,30-32; 14:5-10a
- 2) He had the proper perspective as he perceived his place
- 3) He was a man of great <u>purpose</u> & <u>passion</u>: He pursued what God has promised
- 4) He was persistent
- 5) He <u>passed</u> it along to the next generation Joshua 15:13-19

The Lord provided what He had promised to Caleb

Lessons we learn and can apply this week

- The Lord's call for everyone is to follow Him wholeheartedly this week – with everything that we are!
- 2. Sometimes the Lord calls us to stand alone but we're never alone because He is always with us.

- 3. The Lord is never through using you: no matter your age, your past, your circumstances, etc..
- 4. We are all called to disciple & pass along our faith to the next generation especially on our children/grandchildren.
- 5. The Lord promises to reward those who faithfully serve Him and follow Him wholeheartedly.

- 2. Why is it so hard sometimes to stand firm, especially today, when you feel you are the only standing? How does this message encourage you to take that stand?

- 4. Why do people sometimes feel you can retire from serving the Lord? How can you avoid that trap?
- 5. In what area of your life do you need to be persistent in following the Lord's direction and promise to you? How will you do that this week?
