The Call – imitate the Father vs. 1-2

- 1) Love Him & walk in His love
- 2) Love others the way He loves us

- 1) The sin to evade vs. 3-6
- 2) The change that ensues vs. 7-10
- 3) The action to embrace vs. 11-14

The Caution – consider your life vs. 15-21

- 1) Be careful with your time vs. 15-17
- 2) Be full of the Spirit vs. 18-21
 - a) singing
 - b) thanksgiving
 - c) submission
