The Words we added last week were Available & Abandoned

I Need to be Deeply **Affected** and Always **Absorbing** the Deep Love of God in my life. So we add the final two words – **Affected & Absorbing**. Our challenge is to understand that the “rediscovery” of the gospel should be a lifelong process that never ends. We began our Christian life by drinking from Christ’s everlasting water. We don’t grow in Christ by enlarging the circumference of our well; we grow in Christ by digging deeper into it.

“The gospel is not a well we drink from one time and then move on from. The gospel is a well we plunge deeper and deeper into. We’ll never get to the bottom. This is a journey we will be on for the rest of eternity.” **J.D. Greear** That’s what we want to talk about this morning – never getting to the bottom – whether you already know Christ as your Savior and Lord or whether this morning our prayer is that you meet Him today for the first time – we will never get to the end of God’s love for us!
