3 Truths To Follow Vs 2-4

- 1) I must obey & share it Vs 2
- 2) I must trust Him completely Vs 3
 - a) God’s timing is perfect Ecclesiastes 3:1-8
 - b) God’s plan is certain Isaiah 55:10-11
 - c) God’s plan isn’t slow 2 Peter 3:9; Isaiah 30:18 (CSB), Galatians 6:9
- 3) I must live by faith Vs 4-5
Isaiah 26:2 (CSB); Romans 1:16-17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:37-38

5 Warnings of God’s Judgment Vs 6-20

- 1) The thief will be stolen from Vs 6-8
- 2) The secure will become unsecure Vs 9-11
- 3) The destroyer will be devastated Vs 12-14
- 4) Their glory will be replaced with shame Vs 15-17
- 5) The idols they worship will be worthless Vs 18-20
Romans 1:25

3 Powerful Reminders

- 1) **Everyone will one day know who the Lord is** Vs 14
Isaiah 11:9; Philippians 2:9-11

- 2) **The Lord is still on His throne and in control** Vs 20
Psalms 11:4; 115:1-9

- 3) **Be still before the Lord and listen**
Zephaniah 1:7; Zechariah 2:13; Psalms 46:10

2. Habakkuk 2:4 says, “The righteous one will live by his faith.” What does this mean to you and why is this so important to the gospel?

4. What idols do people worship today? What idols do you tend to lean on? In what ways are they powerless and foolish compared to the Lord?
5. How can the 3 powerful reminders help and encourage you today in what you might be facing?
