The Background v. 1

- 1) He is totally <u>desperate</u>
- 2) His nation is decaying Isaiah 59:4
- 3) He has a deep desire Nehemiah 1:11

# Habakkuk has questions vs. 2-4

- 1) It's ok to have questions and to ask them vs. 2-4 Psalms 13
- 2) The Lord invites us to bring our questions to Him
- 3) Our desire & passion must be right Daniel 9:17, 19

## God's Response & Answer vs. 5-11

- 1) I <u>hear you and I will answer you</u> Exodus 2:4; Micah 7:7; Jonah 2:2; Psalm 6:9
- 2) I am working and have been working Exodus 34:10; Psalm 111:7; John 5:17
- 3) I am going to do it My way in My time Psalm 92:5; Isaiah 55:8-9; 45:11 (NLT); 2 Peter 3:9
