- 5) They were self-sufficient
- 6) They were shocked & stumbled at His words
- 7) They were stubborn

- 2) Believe in Me

- 3) Don't work for something that won't last
- 4) I will lose no one the Father has given to me
- 5) I came to do the will of my Father
- 6) I am the Bread of Life and the Living Water

- 7) Eat of my flesh and drink of my blood *Psalm 34:8; 119:103; Jeremiah 15:16; Matthew 4:4*

The Call

- 1) Pursue Jesus daily
- 2) Pursue pleasing Jesus
- 3) Pursue the eternal and not the physical
- 4) Pursue being & not just the doing
