A Look at the Song & Isaiah 7:14

- ✓ This is a passionate plea from His people
- ✓ This is a promise
- ✓ This was the <u>prescription</u> for our plight
- ✓ This was God's perfect plan
- ✓ This was a <u>picture</u> of who God is
- 1. God <u>is</u> always with us He stands <u>beside</u> us 2 Chronicles 32:8; Psalm 46:7; Isaiah 8:10
- 2. God <u>has</u> always been with us He is behind us Genesis 26:28a; 1 Kings 8:57;
- God will always be with us He goes before & beyond us Revelation 1:8
 - ✓ Nothing can <u>separate</u> me from God's love I'm safe Romans 8:35-39
 - ✓ Nothing can <u>snatch</u> me out of His hand I'm saved John 10:27-29
 - ✓ Nothing can shake or sink me I'm <u>secure</u>

Psalm 16:8; 55:22; 62:6

- ✓ Nothing can <u>steal</u> my joy I'm <u>satisfied</u> John 15:11
