

Guided Prayer for June 21-27 PSALMS

- June 21** **Psalm 41-4** Pray the Lord would examine you and search your heart. Pray the God would give you a desire for His presence this week. Ask Him to show you anything in your life that may be hindering you from hearing his voice.
- June 22** **Psalm 47-48** As you wake up this morning, spend some time thanking God for who He is, what He has done, and everything He has entrusted to you. As you spend time thanking God, pray and ask Him to reveal anything in your life that you have placed above Him. Spend some time thanking God for His Lordship over your life.
- June 23** **Psalm 50** As you pray, may you declare God's goodness over your live and your family. Pray as you go about your day, if you encounter hardship, God would remind you that He is the judge over all.
- June 24** **Psalm 51** Praise Him today for restoring you. Praise Him for His mercy and his abundant compassion. Ask God to show you who you need to show mercy and abundant compassion to others. Thank God for taking away your sin and making you righteous in His sight.
- June 25** **Psalm 52-53** Pray you would trust in the Lord and not in yourself or anything else. Pray God would guard your tongue and your heart today. Ask the Spirit of God to intercede for you, to give you the words to speak at the right moment so you can be the example of Jesus.
- June 26** **Psalm 56-57** Today, may you wait patiently on the Lord. May you see that God is your protector. As you pray, thank God for protecting you. Thank Him for His patience with you. Ask God as you become afraid or worried, that He would remind you of His power over your life.
- June 27** **Psalm 55** Thank the Lord for being your refuge. Ask God to help you put your faith in Him today. Ask God to put someone on your heart who you need to pray for and pray for them. Ask God to put someone on your family's heart to pray for too.

Discussion

1. What does it look like to desire God? Do you desire God? If not, why? What are some things you can do as a family to strengthen each of your desires to grow in your relationship with Jesus?
2. Are you being restored by God? What do you think that means? What do you think that process looks like?
3. Who in your life and circle of influence doesn't know Jesus? Psalm 55 tells of the betrayal of a friend. To add, the greatest betrayal we can do for someone who doesn't know Jesus is not pray for them to receive Him. Go around and share with your family who that is and spend time praying together for those people.
