ANGELS

- Immanuel God With Us From Matthew 1 & John 1
- Holy Child He was pure, sinless, perfect (See last week's message)
- Son of the Most High (God) Son of God "And He (Jesus) is the radiance of His (God) glory and the exact representation of His nature..." Heb. 1:3 Jesus used this title of Himself, God did, Satan, the demons and Paul did. It tell us who He is and what He was qualified to do!
- **Jesus** means Savior From Hebrew name Joshua Jehovah is salvation "He who will save His people from their sins"
- He was Jesus, the Christ (Anointed) Greek equivalent of Messiah
- He will be Great
- He will take the throne of David and reign over the house of Jacob forever His Kingdom will have no end
- A Savior Who is Christ the Lord From Luke 2:11

SIMEON Luke 2:27-35

- My Salvation & Yours
- A Light of Revelation to the Gentiles (It wasn't just for the Jews)
- Glory of Thy people Israel (Both of these referring back to Isaiah) This was Israel's true glory which was to be a light to the nations.
- Appointed for the Rise and Fall of Many
- A Sign to Be Opposed
- He Will Reveal the Hearts of Man
- A Sword Will Pierce Your Own Soul (to Mary)

What do we learn about Him through these names?

- He is the Savior of the World
- He is the King and his Kingdom will never end

- He is both God and man
- He brings the gospel for everyone
- He is present, He came, He is not absent
- He reveals the hearts of men, to let them see themselves as they really are, sinners in need of a Savior.

What do we learn about God through Jesus?

- **He is Humble** What more of a humble birth for the Son of God. A common name. From a little town. No fanfare outside of the angel announcement, only shepherds came
- **He is Approachable** We don't have to fear, He is waiting to hear from us. All we have to do is call on His name
- **He is Understandable** He is not confusing, The gospel is simple. He understand us even better than we understand ourselves. He can say to us, I understand I have been there and done that.
- He is Worthy of Our Worship

Why did He do all this?

- **Because He Loved us before we ever loved Him.** He loves us more than we can even fathom or understand.
- So that we could we could know who God is. God wants to be known, He does not play hide and go seek. He wants us to know Him.
- So that we could worship Him and bring glory & fame to His name
- So that we could have our sins forgiven
- So that we could have eternal life in heaven
- So that we could experience hope
- So that we could have a reason to live
