- 1) The challenge of constant <u>criticism</u> disregard it vs. 1-3
  - a) The correct comeback <u>deliver</u> them to the Lord vs. 4-5
  - **b)** Continue the course <u>dedicate</u> yourself to the task v. 6
- 2) Conspiracy compounds the crisis <u>discern</u> the depth of it vs. 7-8
  - a) Counteract it through communion with the Lord *devote* yourself to Him v. 9a
  - **b)** Create a <u>balance</u> determine a way forward v. 9b
  - c) Consider that discouragement is <u>certain</u> *don't dismiss it* vs. 10 -12
- 3) Choose to calculate a plan & champion the cause decide & depend vs. 13-14
  - a) Comprehend the <u>concerns</u> don't deny it they were afraid v. 14a
  - **b)** Coordinate a common sense plan discern & decide the next steps vs. 13, 16-23

- d) Challenge people to contend for their clan dare to fight for what matters most v. 14c
- e) Collectively come together at the cry demand <u>unity</u> & <u>loyalty</u> v. 20
- f) <u>Carry</u> on with the <u>call</u> declare we will forge ahead v. 15
