   ✓ The confrontation this is wrong
   ✓ The challenge stop & give it back

## **Persevere through Personal Opposition**

- 1) Disregard the <u>outside</u> pressure 6:1-9
  - ✓ Decide not to <u>compromise</u>
  - ✓ Dismiss the coercions

- 2) Deal with the inside pressure 6:10-14
  - ✓ <u>Discern</u> if it's of God or not
  - ✓ Determine if it goes against God's Word
- 3) Determine to push <u>forward</u> 6:15-19
  - ✓ Stay the course
  - ✓ Stand <u>firm</u>
