- 1. Jesus doesn't choose the <u>best</u>, He chooses the <u>willing</u>. v. 18 Acts 4:13; I Corinthians 1:26-29 (Phillips); Matthew 11:11
- 2. We didn't choose Him, He chose us. v. 19 Philippians 1:6; John 15:16 (CSB); Ephesians 1:3-4; Ephesians 2:10
- **3. Our primary calling is to be with Jesus.** v. 19 Mark 3:13-14; John 15:4-5
- **4.** We must be willing to leave everything to follow Him. v. 20 Luke 9:23-25; Matthew 10:37-39; John 6:66-69 (Phillips)
- 5. He commands us to spiritually <u>reproduce</u> make <u>disciples</u> who make <u>disciples</u>. Vs 21-22
